I submit this comment in opposition of the Grand Targhee Master Development plan. Specifically the expansion out of bounds into the mono trees and south bowl, and two on mountain restaurants.

As an Idaho resident who loves skiing Targhee, I understand the resorts missions and vision of what it would like to offer to the outdoor recreation community, however, I firmly feel that the public lands surrounding Targhee should not be available to a privately owned business for profit and development. Especially with the current threat of public lands becoming available for sale. Some things just should not be for sale/profit.

Additionally, the proposal for two restaurants situated at the top of lifts would not only be an eye sore from the valley, but be visible from the Teton range and national park. Restaurants don't belong on mountain tops.

While I would support more food and beverage options at the base, ultimately I will have been totally priced out of skiing at Targhee by the time any of this happens, so it is all a no from me. We don't want to pay the resort anymore money, especially not to access valuable outdoor recreation resources like Teton canyon, which we can currently enjoy for free, and fosters a rich habitat for wildlife.
