As a Lakota woman, many of the Lakota Oyate have cultural ties to these lands.

I respectfully urge the Forest Service to conduct a full Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for this project. An EIS is necessary to thoroughly assess the long-term effects of exploratory drilling on this ecologically and culturally sensitive region.

This project poses several potential threats that should be closely examined and avoided:

- *Cultural and historical resources sacred to Indigenous peoples
- *Water quality and availability, especially considering the region's reliance on clean groundwater
- *Wildlife habitats and ecosystem health
- *Recreational use that supports local economies
- *Potential for economic harm from contamination or environmental degradation

Additionally, I ask that the public comment period be extended by 60 days to ensure that all community members have a fair opportunity to review the proposal and respond.

Please consider the long-term impact of this project on our environment, communities, and future generations. I appreciate the opportunity to provide input and urge you to prioritize transparency, environmental integrity, and Indigenous voices in this process.
