I live in EagleVail and read recently in the Vail Daily that there is a proposal to run power transmission lines from Avon to Gilman. Some part of the pathway will be underground in Minturn. But other pathways will be above ground between EagleVail and Avon. I am totally opposed to this proposal. As the Vail Daily article stated:

"Homestake Peak School is currently the staging area for wildfire response efforts in the upper Eagle River and Gore Creek valleys, something that would likely change if the transmission lines are run above ground near the school."

"When those transmission lines go in, they can no longer do helicopters into HPS, it takes away our staging area [mdash] this most up-valley staging area [mdash] and it pushes us down into the Avon and Edwards area for fire staging, and that is a big deal when you're talking about getting the town of Vail and the town of Minturn out on one single pathway."
