- 1) expand parking lots at each trailhead (quandary, lower McCullough gulch, blue lakes and spruce)
- 2) make 50% of the parking free and FCFS; the remaining 50% of parking is paid
- 3) add better signs and info in Breck so it's obvious where to park and catch the shuttle; be sure the "welcome center" has this info posted
- 4) add restrooms at each trailhead

- 6) add shuttle stop at Lower McCullough gulch parking lot that takes people to quandary trailhead (for those of us that live in this area)
