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Comments: The Roadless Rule is important because it protects roughly 58 million acres of wild forestland from road construction, logging, and mining, preserving critical habitats, ensuring clean drinking water supplies for millions, mitigating climate change by storing carbon, and saving taxpayers money by preventing the creation and maintenance of costly new infrastructure. This rule also safeguards diverse ecosystems, ancient migration routes, and the natural world for various species and allows for non-destructive recreational opportunities.
