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1)The listed "range of relative stand density (or % of SDI max)

Pine - 50-150

Dry Mixed Conifer - 100-200

Moist Mixed Conifer - 150-250"

appears to be displaying a range of "basal area" rather than relative stand density (SDI). For example, if the goal was minimal competition between residual trees, you would expect an SDI of around 35.

2) Retaining oak greater than 10-inch DBH is an objective. Where oak is a significant vegetative component, the oak can impact sunlight, water, and soil nutrients and "compete" with Pine and Mixed Conifer. I would think the analysis would include the oak component along with the Pine and Mixed Conifer components in determining residual trees in a manner that meets an SDI goal.
