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Comments: I strongly support timber harvest, thinning, and fuels reduction detailed in the Upper Bunk Fuels Reduction Project in Yaak Montana. The Kootenai National Forest is badly in need of active management for the health of the forest and to reduce wildland fire risk. Grizzly bears do just fine with logging roads. The forest is so dense and there is so much dead timber that dirt roads and skid paths are their preferred routes of travel. Logging will also improve the habitat for other wildlife as well.
