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Comments: I have numerous concerns about this proposed logging, all of which were outlined in the OPA letter. From working in the forest for over 20 years doing Spotted Owl surveys, I know that advanced forest structures are necessary. This public land does not need to be thinned, especially not without a full EIS or following the full NEPA process.

I also have observed that forest regeneration in the upper Dungeness watershed struggle. Several past logging project in that area have failed to produce thriving trees, perhaps due to soil structure, and additional climate warming will make future thriving trees difficult to get established. For these reasons, let's let this mature forest not have to endure the impacts of logging, roads etc...

also of note is ESA listed salmon runs in the Dungeness watershed.

Let's keep the forest service lands of the upper dungeness to grow and be healthy for future generations of not only humans, but for all species that call that area home.
