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Comments: I have serious concerns with the Canyon Forest Restoration Project, which would devastate a large area of natural, older forests which have stood for as much as 164 years. These legacy forests do not need thinning or treatment of any kind, and should be preserved as they are now. The project has also not received adequate study, and requires a full environmental impact statement under the National Environmental Policy Act. This EIS must be carried out before a decision is made on the Canyon Forest Restoration Project.

Rather than logging in forest such as this which will not benefit from this so-called restoration project, you should instead thin low-diversity replanted forests, and leave older legacy forests alone.
