My first and most urgent request is that there needs to be more and better organized evacuation planning. I don't know the involvement of the Forest Service in that effort. But making public land available for more roads should be mandatory for them, as they control 80% of the land in the basin.

Secondly the vegetation management needs to be stepped up dramatically. Before Caldor there was a 20 year lag in burning dead wood piles at the LTB!

Thirdly there needs to be a unified fire response at the Lake. County and Forest Service fire fighters in both states need to collaborate under a central command with the same goals and objectives.

An assessment of wider vegetation abatement perimeters needs to be prepared and executed including enforcement.

Overall policies regarding fire response and controlled burns forest density and composition and other fire prevention needs to be formulated and practiced.

Lastly, there needs to be accountability and transparency build into each step of this new plan. Starting with individuals and commanding personel.
