Comments: I have reviewed the proposed plan regarding forest recovery necessitated by the Candor Fire, and I have the following comments:

1 - Aggressive harvesting of fire damaged/killed trees must take place, but under no circumstances should living trees over 120 years old be harvested. Full stop. Living trees that show fire damage should be retained at a density of 30 stems per acre.

2 - Care must be taken in forest rehabilitation efforts near water courses. No harvesting should take place within a 200 foot corridor along class 1 and class 2 water courses. No harvesting should take place within a 100 foot corridor along class 3 and class 4 water courses.

3 - To accelerate forest recovery, native species trees and vegetation should be planted in fire damaged areas.

4 - Roads may be built in fire damaged areas but must be removed and the land rehabilitated once recovery projects are completed.
