Comments: As a frequent user and maintainer of the Ozark and Berryman Trails, I would love to see policies enforced that provide a protective corridor for the trail. It has been very frustrating when very nice sections of trail have been heavily damaged by timber harvest, and become nearly impossible to maintain due to briars and weeds growing over the trail in the absence of any remaining tree canopy. There are sections that I used to enjoy maintaining because the trail was beautiful and shaded and only required occasional tree or limb clearing. Now, with heavy harvest along many sections of trail in recent years, long sections require arduous line trimming in summer to keep the path open. It is miserable work, making it difficult to sustain with volunteer labor.
