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Comments: I believe the Pikes Peak Vegetation Management Restoration Project should be modified in the following ways:

*I believe it would be more appropriate for a smaller project focusing on protecting infrastructure, instead of the large project currently proposed.

*The project should stay completely out of habitat for the listed threatened species and not destroy or degrade critical habitat for Mexican Spotted Owl, Prebles meadow jumping mouse, and lynx.

*There should be no logging or road construction occur in roadless areas. The current plan proposes 13,500 acres across four Colorado FS Roadless Areas.

*Treatment should be focused on areas near homes and other infrastructure.

* Higher altitude forests should not be logged; spruce/fir, bristlecone/limber pine, and lodgepole pine forests are not as dense, do not burn as often so do not need to be logged.
