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Comments: The "Pike's Peak" project as proposed does not meet the standards of "best available science" for such "fuel reduction" logging supposedly "protecting communities" or "reducing high-severity wildfire."

Specifically, this should be transitioning jobs towards using the latest technologies and that means electric and leaving things better than before which means planting and harvests of no more than 10% of non-contiguous stands of trees and specifically NO old growth nor surrounding supportive biomes by old growth ecosystems including any tree aged over 100 years old. Considerations for selective harvesting should be no more than 10% of reasonably sized trees with small diameters at breast height depending on at least 3-10 local professional certified arborist evaluations and leaving figure small saplings and seedlings to grow.
