Comments: I am making public my opposition to the proposed logging along the HWY 2 Corridor south of Glacier National Park into the Great Bear Wilderness and adjacent USFS lands. This area is critical for wildlife travel of several endangered species and threatened plants. Logging here would negatively impact the Middle Fork of the Flathead River home to the endangered Bull Trout. Sediment and run off from logging and the introduction of invasive plant species would take a tremendous toll on this health of Glacier National Park, the Great Bear, Bob Marshall and tourism.

Additionally, I see the value of forest health around the Izaak Walton Inn and the Walton Ranger Station (which is not a tourist attraction).

I have lived in, hunted, fished and recreated in this area since 1988. I beg you not to open a logging operation along the Hwy 2/ Great Bear Corridor !
