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Comments: The Forest Service should drop its proposed Forest Plan amendment for the White Mountain National Forest as it considers how to address wilderness trail management. Amending the Forest Plan to allow new trails and trail relocation throughout Wilderness could weaken protections for currently trailless areas, which help protect plants and wildlife, keep Wilderness from being overrun by humans, and offer a truly primitive experience for those who venture into these areas. All new trail and trail relocation work in Wilderness should be completed using traditional skills and tools, rather than motorized and mechanized equipment.
