As a grazing permit holder in the Powder River Ranger District, I feel it is important to allow flexibility in the time of grazing so as to reduce conflicts during any high times of climbing activity. As an example, in early July there is usually a festival held and the number of people increases. We try to get cattle moved up the canyon before the festival or wait till after, it just makes it better for us all. Hopefully if needed the PRRD would support allowing cattle on early enough to avoid the increase in climbing activity. Also, considering resource readiness.

It is important that the PRRD involves grazing permittees on the location of toilets, so as to not build where livestock trail. It is important that the PRRD involves grazing permittees in the building of any new infrastructure roads, bridges or parking.
