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Comments: The Forest Service should drop its proposed Forest Plan amendment for the White Mountain National Forest as it considers how to address wilderness trail management. The agency should first analyze and create a trail monitoring report and then consider trail management options. Doing so would include site-specific analysis, transparency, and a more informed commenting process. The Forest Service should make every effort to relocate trails in Wilderness within established trail corridors. All new trail and trail relocation work in Wilderness should be completed using traditional skills and tools, rather than motorized and mechanized equipment. It is disheartening how all government agencies are ignoring the Wilderness mandate of using NO mechanized equipment.
