Comments: As an environmentally motivated voter who is committed to the preservation of our unique American species and ecosystems, I point to several modifications to the Environmental Assessment for Forestwide Thinning Analysis #68852 for Mt Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest that would better protect species and forests. Because the project is broad in scale and the planned activities are complex, more specifics of basins and sites and more specific community feedback are needed if the evaluation is to be accurate. Similarly, the plan should be divided into four parts by district with distinct plans suited to the specific situations of each of the four. These measures will promote a thinning that will be more likely to avoid the harms that poorly-conceived thinning inflicts.
