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Comments: 1. The Granite Moccasin Project smells a lot like the spotted owl. To log this corridor will only open up the forest to future wind events, uprooting many of the remaining trees.

2. Building new roads in the middle fork is a bad idea. Glacier on the north, Great Bear Wilderness on the south. We know roads add sediment to downstream flows.

3. If roads are built, wildlife crossings and connectivity must be prioritized.

4. Looking at the completed logging projects around West Glacier, after wind storms have swept through, there is a complete mess left.
