Comments: Thank you for taking public comment, although I wish the comment period was longer! Please consider additional opportunities for public engagement when the draft EA is released.

Please note that I oppose the proposed Granite Moccasin project #68919

I'm concerned that the proposed treatments will destroy critical fish and wildlife habitat and could negatively impact wildlife connectivity across the US-2 corridor.

Please consider not developing new roads in the corridor - Roads are ecologically damaging, harmful to fish and wildlife, and economically costly.

White Bark Pine restoration in recommended Wilderness should only use hand tools and non-motorized methods of access and treatment.

This area is iconic! The stretch of Hwy 2 (through the project area) offers a unique and scenic drive through a wild place. It's a treasured experience for visitors to Glacier National Park. The extensive logging proposed in this plan would drastically change the natural beauty of the corridor.

The extent of proposed logging in the area seems disproportionate to the inventory of structures the project is intended to protect. It also seems inappropriate to use emergency authorization for this proposed treatment.
