I am disappointed that the Forest Service will be using glyphosate and other herbicides to manage vegetation in this project. There have been proven links between herbicides and cancer, and I really think the Forest Service needs to collaborate with our health leaders before undertaking such a dangerous experiment that will harm our children. I also worry that the massive amount of carbon released with a project as destructive as this will also harm our children's health. Quite a few kiddos that I see just by being around smoke and smoke particles. How are we making sure that the prescribed fires will not harm our children?
