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Comments: Do not log in the Tongass. It is our national treasure won by blood and survival. Alaska's Tongass National Forest is one of the last great wild places. The timber industry in the Tongass is economically unsustainable, it is a drain on the American taxpayer.

Logging in the Tongass is heavily subsidized, with every dollar of timber revenue costing taxpayers far more in infrastructure, road maintenance and environmental mitigation. Tourism in the area is what keeps the people there surviving. With so few places left on earth of this magnificence - the world needs to care for these places first and foremost.
