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Comments: I strongly object to the South Revilla Integrated Resource Project #53477. I have witnessed tens of thousands of additional acres of previously roadless old growth Tongass National Forest be clearcut by Native Corporations and State of Alaska Mental Health Trust since the Ketchikan Pulp Mill closed in 1997. And an additional 115,200 acres is being proposed to be given away in the Landless Bill, the majority of it in the Ketchikan area. The Tongass is a national treasure, the jewel of the USFS. Once clearcut there is no way to recover what is lost when the value of this unique environment is measured only in board feet of timber. What remains of the Tongass coastal temperate rainforest with its fossilized coral reef should be designated as a World Heritage Site, not an Integrated Resource Project.
