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Comments: As a longtime resident of Eagle Creek Road, I am completely against this project. The recent thinning projects up Walker Canyon destroyed, shady, cool, non-brushy sections of forest. They have now become hotter, drier, and will quickly fill in with shrubbery and small trees much more prone to fire. The hillside across from me is a refuge for wildlife and is mostly unbothered by human activities. This project will open up new roads and clear out existing habitat. Once the project is complete, people will inevitably explore the new roads they opened up creating the potential for more human caused fires via campfires, shooting, motorized vehicles, and smoking. There is a significant profit motive for the logging companies and contractors to focus on taking out valuable trees instead of focusing exclusively on fire prevention. I am certain this project will leave much of the area hotter, drier, less suitable for wildlife, and more vulnerable to human-caused forest fire. Please reconsider this ill-advised thinning project. It will ruin a beloved area and will do nothing to prevent future fires.
