Comments: I oppose the Twin Mountain II Timber Sale Project due to its likely impacts on forest health, wildlife habitat, and climate resilience.

Mature forests play a critical role in carbon storage, biodiversity, and water protection. Logging and road-building risk fragmenting habitat, increasing erosion, and degrading water quality. These impacts are especially concerning when considered alongside cumulative disturbances in the area.
