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Comments: This proposal risks fundamentally changing what makes Pinecrest special. Expanding commercial activity in a National Forest setting sets a troubling precedent that prioritizes short-term convenience over long-term stewardship. When even the Environmental Assessment acknowledges increased congestion, safety risks, and infrastructure strain, it's hard to justify moving forward under a finding of "No Significant Impact." Pinecrest is already feeling the pressure of overcrowding, and further development could erode the very character and natural experience that draw people there in the first place. Protecting this space means recognizing its limits and ensuring it remains a place for recreation, not commercialization.
