Comments: I am writing to suggest that the Forest Service should not be even CONSIDERING the Telluride Ski Resort's Improvement proposals based upon TSG's dismal record of operations over the past several years. As of this writing, TSG apparently has no CEO, no Director of Mountain Operations, no Director of Mountain Safety, and no General Manager. The owner is absent and lives in California.
