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Comments: It is important to add more protected land around watershed areas. The health of the streams is vital to the health of the Tongass.

Stop cutting Old Growth Trees now. There is enough second growth to supply Alaska mills now. Old Growth forest is not renewable. Once removed it is gone. There are very few Old Growth areas in the world. The Tongass Old Growth is 600-800 years old. Anywhere else in the US they would protected like the Old Redwood trees in California. These old trees are irreplaceable and are a treasured resource for the American people and the world.

No High Commercial use on Kruzoff island. This level of activity would destroy the beauty and magic of Kruzoff island.
