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Comments: I value the Tongass National Forest for its carbon storage, particularly all old growth forest. I also note that preserving its ecosystem intact is critical for our fisheries which are a major industry in SE Alaska and Sitka. For these reasons, I do not want timber extraction or mining extraction to increase. Specifically, I do not want any commercial development on Baranof and Kruzof Islands. Our way of life close to nature is already threatened by increased cruise ship tourism that is not capped at tolerable numbers. I do not want development of Kruzof Island into tourist sites with zip-lines, trinket commercialism, and increased boat traffic for wildlife viewing. The Tongas Forest is invaluable as wilderness. No commercial extraction is worth the few jobs that would result or the private wealth that is generated at the expense of the commons for humanity as a whole and a stable climate.
