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Comments: As someone who loves to ski, mountain bike and some who has lived and worked here for the past 7 years, I am against Telski's expansion. Specifically for the projects of widening the galloping goose skiway, a jaws ski way, transform the existing High Camp warming hut into a full service restaurant, build a new mountain bike connection trail, make the installations on the Heritage Trail permanent, and conduct tethered logging projects for forest health.

I see the majority of these projects with the sole focus of bringing in outside revenue, with no consideration to the environment impacts that this will have. I think Telski has an appropriate amount of trails and I see very little benefit of them expanding these trails. These expansions benefit the tourism but will not get very much use from locals as these are not the type of "expansions" that locals would use. I also find it surprising that Telski is interesting in building a full restaurant at the top of 12, when Guiseppes is clearly still not finished after all that construction that closed down the summer trails for people to be on. It also seems, especially after this winter that we don't really have tourism to support these expansions.

I do think lift replacement could be considered as there will be less destruction to the environment with lift lines all ready cut.
