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Comments: Thanks for looking after our trails! I'm both a mountain biker and hiker.

On the Aspen Alley rebuild I feel that some money could be saved by simply closing the trail to bikers during the peak leaf peeping season. Divert the money to other trails.

If the consensus is to go ahead with the rebuild, and a new trail is being built parallel to the existing trail, why not keep both trails open and dedicate one to bikes and one to foot traffic? In this case, the new trail need not be so wide since it's not necessary to accommodate both bikes and foot traffic. 4 ft wide with 10 ft clearance seems very wide, possibly excessively so?
