It just leaves the spindly trees that sway and break with the wind and heavy snow. Not to mention chasing off the wildlife, destroying the birds' nests and displacing other wildlife. We've lived here for 9 years now and it is very disheartening to see the intense logging in areas that were once so beautiful and majestic. The loggers leave scars with their big machinery rutting up the ground, seldom do they clean up after themselves and just leave more deadfall that creates fire hazards. Why is nothing ever cleaned up? I've contacted all of the congressmen/women that are involved with projects before. They never call back. But, they do give some pre-written or recorded message that they 'care'..I don't think they do. Please do something before it's too late and our forest is gone. It does need some managing but not the massacre of the beautiful Ponderosa trees that is happening all over.
