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Comments: I believe this project is great and fully support it. The Forest Service has made the decision to suppress all fires thus altering the ecosystem by increasing fuel loading and fire risk to the community. This project would help to be more proactive in reducing the impact of forest fires. Relative to the ecosystem this is a pretty small project. There are several examples in the local community of doing fuel projects removing trees on private land as well as in Yellowstone National Park conducting hundreds of acres of fuels treatments each year that have not had a negative impact on the community. The area gets relatively little tourist visitation. The few local outfitters would have some impact. Hopefully lessons were learned on the Forest Service project in West Yellowstone in reducing blowdown in the cutting units for Lodgepole Pine.
