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Comments: I am writing to comment on the proposed logging of 8500 acres of forest in the Trinity Alps Wilderness.

The infrastructure required to log at this scale (roads and landings) while marked as "temporary" will not be temporary in any rational timeline for the stakeholders. It will permanently scar the countryside and the only thing temporary will be the maintenance of the roads.

There is a startling lack of oversight from the Forestry agency over the activities of the logging companies and past experiences show that they do not abide by the conservation rules that are part of the project.

There are better solutions for Fire Safety which is the major reason stated for this. Using the existing infrastructure to remove small diameter trees to reduce ladder fuel and investing in home hardening would be a better solution for the residents of the area.

The endangered wildlife in this area will surely be negatively impacted by this activity as well.
