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Comments: I can't understand how anyone can, in good conscience, think it's a good idea to rip up forests and terrain to make Waterville Valley more money at the expense of the ecosystem, the animals and birds who depend on it to survive, the water table, and the air. This disgusting expansion will make it harder for the lynx, bats, and other animals to survive and be healthy. It will create noise and disruption, not just during construction but afterwards, when the gondola is running and the new buildings will be occupied and used.

If WVR does not consider itself competitive enough and believes they will become more competitive through this project (which is not guaranteed), it's hard not to see it as a clear case of greed. I just hate the way so many corporations and businesses think it's more important for them to get what they want regardless of the impact on the environment. Shame on them for doing this.
