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Comments: I urge you not to implement this plan. There is a wealth of research showing that forest thinning and burning of vegetation do not help mitigate wildfires. In fact, it's just the opposite - healthy forests with dense vegetation are more resilient to wildfires. This plan is ineffective and destructive to wildlife, and it will pollute the air we breathe. I urge you to seek input and guidance from scientific studies and indigenous communities before taking action on this issue. There are several more effective methods we can use to mitigate wildfires, such as bringing beavers back onto the land to help spread and slow the water and keep our forests moist, or actions to increase water flow to the great salt lake to help our lake effect and snowpack. We need our forests, we love our trees. Please, let's work together to come up with a more effective and less destructive plan.
