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Comments: The U.S. Forest Service has released their draft decision allowing Grand Targhee to expand into an additional 694 acres. This is vital habitat on public land for bighorn sheep, grizzly bears, and other wildlife. It will permit activity and tree removal in areas protected under the existing forest plan for goshawks, falcons and small owls. I agree to new development at Targhee within its existing footprint, but I oppose the Alternative 2 expansion and on-mountain restaurants. This expansion is not driven by the traditional "multiple use sustained yield" principles that have governed professional U.S. Forest Service decisions for decades. It came from a White House "fatwa", sometimes called an executive order, putting a thumb on the scale in favor of industrial recreation.
