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Comments: The dangers of wildfire smoke, kills about 10,000 people a year. Prescribed fire smoke is five times more toxic than wildfire smoke. Forest Service wants to burn 300 acres a day for the next five years during the spring and fall. That smoke will go down into the valley and be trapped. Prescribed fires are 5x more toxic than regular wildfires. Burning and thinning the forests of the canyon under the guise of 'preventing a big wildfire' makes no more sense than thinning your brain to prevent alzheimers.

The forest service is in league with the logging industry. Thinning forests makes them hotter, drier, and opens them up to much greater wind which are the REAL wildfire risks.

Do NOT proceed with your planned toxic prescribed burns. PLEASE.
