Has been for at least 35 years. I think it started in 1988, maybe 1987? Either way, the lift's uphill capacity can not keep up with the demands of Telluride Ski Area today. When it is busy, it is usual to see hundreds of people walking up the meadows trail to get in the line and then side-slipping their way down to the lift. This is not the guest-experience that brings people back. And I will tell you as a ski instructor for the last 30 plus years, these are the people Telski needs to retain! A new lift 10 could fit into summer programs easily too. Hiking/biking combinations with the top of the gondola pop into my mind. Plus the top of Ten seems like an ideal site to build a restaurant to alleviate this other sore spot for the guests on the mountain. For summer and winter. Everyone would like to see new lifts at 8 and 9, but I think the most bang for the buck a new as far as customer service value (and safety, it is naive to think this lift will go on forever) would be to replace lift 10 and put a restaurant up there.
