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Comments: Quoting page 177 of the FEIS: "These projects have identified a distinct presence of Native American activity in the alpine, with numerous site types ranging from lithic scatters and quarries to open camps and ice patches. While many of the sites are unevaluated and lacking diagnostics, they help dispel the popular public perception of these environments (tree line and above) as "wilderness, devoid of humans and their activities.""

My comment: there should be a distinction between historic Native American activity and expanding a ski resort. Indigenous people respected the land and animals. They didn't believe in owning land. This proposal would significantly disrupt the land and animals. As a member of the Shoshone-Bannock tribe, I find it offensive that you would compare these two very different types of human activity.
