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Comments: Bolting advocacy is best handled by agencies such as the Access Fund and others who push for nuance and holistic approaches to understanding bolting impact on protected Forrest's, wilderness areas, and at risk land. Bolting restrictions should be implemented only after SUP/CPMs have had adequate opportunity for assessment. Blanket statements such as the the five bolt rule in the BLM's recent policy change is an example of natural resource management that is not only ineffective and puts individuals like climbers at risk, but hinders future ability to effectively manage land, especially through community engagement. I strongly urge the Forrest Service to consider those who have dedicated time, effort, and labor to understanding bolting ethics and its environmental impact.
