Comments: I rigorously object to any proposed changes to the forest service Wildlife amendments that would allow for the Targhee expansion because, among other negative impacts, it would weaken or modify existing habitat protections for:

American goshawk

Flammulated owl

Boreal owl

Peregrine falcon

I also object to The Forest Service's proposed Amendment 8, which would permanently redesignate 694 acres in South Bowl and Mono Trees from land managed to protect scenic values and water resources to Special Use Permit Recreation Sites-a designation that allows developed recreation, including ski resort expansion.

Amendment 8 would permanently change how these public lands are managed, extending far beyond this single project.

To allow these amendments to weaken existing Forest Plan protections in an effort to make the proposed Grand Targhee expansion possible is entirely unacceptable. We must protect our lands and defenseless wildlife against greed and unnecessary development.

Because these amendments change the Forest Plan itself, their impacts would weaken the laws that shape how these public lands are managed for decades to come. That is unacceptable.

Please completely reject any proposed changes to the Forest Service management of lands around Targhee at this time.
