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Comments: I am basically opposed to the harvest of the burned trees in the national forests.

The National Forest Service needs to consider allowing a substantial amount of these burned areas to regenerate in a natural ecological process, instead of man-made artificial creation of natural habitat. This would require the burned timber to remain in place and allow nature to take its course and determine the outcome. This would likely create habitat more suitable for a diverse community of plants and animals for the benefit of both nature and man.
