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Comments: I am commenting on the Blue Mountains Forest Plan Revision because motorized access is essential for me, especially when I want to bring older or disabled family members into the forest. If motorized routes are lost or restricted, it directly affects whether we can enjoy and use these public lands. The Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) does not provide enough clear, route-level detail to show how the plan will affect actual roads, routes, Recreation Opportunity Spectrum (ROS) settings, management areas, or future Travel Management decisions. Without maps, route baselines, and plain explanations, the public cannot understand or respond to what these changes mean for real access on the ground. I ask the Forest Service to reject this flawed plan. The final plan must maintain all existing motorized access, restore access that has already been reduced, and prevent any future decisions from causing more access losses.
