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Comments: As a professional biologist, person who hikes and camps, and citizen, I am in favor of greater managed logging in the Blue Mountains draft Forest plan Revision to stimulate a healthier mixed canopy more open forest ecosystems, reduce massive wildfire risk and improve habitat for elk and other plant and animal species. However, plans to define roads, degree of vehicle access and roadless areas are strongly and scientifically needed to also promote a healthy ecosystem and habitat for key species such as elk and their predators. The science is clear that disturbance by motor vehicles must be regulated and modulated throughout the forest plan areas to be appropriate and compatible with elk and other species utilizing the habitat versus being negatively affected and moved off the habitat. The best available science on roads and travel management should be applied rigorously and be a part of the plan to protect the areas from being harmed.
