Along Hwy 21 over the years I have noticed dead trees piling up (behind the pines that line the Hwy) that continue to dry out more and more.

It seems to me this needs to be control burned or somehow reduced tremendously. It's so crowded with dead trees how can anything grow - except mushrooms? Mushrooms would take ions of time to break all of that down so that more trees can grow. Just how complicated an issue is this? Plan ahead - get grants - talk with the governor! Be proactive for our next fires! Manage our forests : you and I love them!
