Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed revision to the Blue Mountains Forest Plan. As a hunter and angler, my primary concern in the plan revision is habitat improvement to support deer, elk, and fish populations. Active management is needed to remove excess timber and improve forage production for deer and elk, but I am deeply concerned with a degradation of habitat that could be caused by increased road construction, particularly if this administration moves ahead with a rescission of the 2001 Roadless Rule (a proposed action I strongly oppose).

With those factors in mind, I would like to register my support for Alternative 3, which prioritizes active management for forest resilience and wildfire mitigation, while permanently protecting the existing roadless areas and riparian areas.
