As an avid equestrian I would like to see more organized parking for trucks with trailers. There are many examples of this including the horse parking at McGinnis Canyon in Fruita, CO. It is a pipe that is place in the dirt so trailers straddle the pipe and it allows a more organized way of parking. I would also like to see signage that this parking is reserved for trucks and trailers only no personal cars.

The other signage if possible is to the hunters who come up and drop their trailers for days or week at a time. There should be a specific place for them to the side of the day use parking and limit the number of trailers ie: 4-6 so it doesn't impact day use equestrians.

I would also love to see a small camping area for equestrians. An area that is flat with 12 x 12 corrals that have water at the campsite and maybe electric. There are many examples of this including the camping at Marvine Campground in the Flattops, the campgrounds at Rabbit Valley (Joufflas Campground) and the campground at Trappers Lake (Horse Thief Campground) Also, if this is done, a place to dump manure is recommended. The only place there isn't a placed to dump manure is at Rabbit Valley, this is a problem because people spread the manure everywhere outside the paddocks.

Those are the only changes I would like to see at Sweetwater. No state park, no concessions, no expanded parking for RVs.
