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Comments: The DEIS does not meaningfully analyze household and subsistence uses like firewood, hunting, food gathering, family access, elderly and disabled access, grazing, emergency access, and other rural uses tied to practical motorized access.

The Forest Service says access and Travel Management are outside this plan, but the plan still adopts ROS settings, management areas, standards, guidelines, roadless assumptions, wildlife direction, riparian direction, and monitoring language that can shape future access decisions for decades.

I just want to make sure our forests that are owned by the Public will continue to be multi-use and that all decisions include the public that uses it.
